- Winter Intake (September): Applications open Feb 15, admission deadlines July 15
- Important Note: Application deadlines vary and are often limited. Early application is always recommended!
- Selected Universities also have Intakes in JANUARY, MARCH, MAY, SEPTEMBER & **NOVEMBER**
